Pet Summer and Travel Safety Tips

Summertime should be fun for everyone in the family including the pets. Hopefully, these tips will help keep everyone happy and healthy.

- *** Never, ever, EVER leave your pets in a hot car. It can take minutes MINUTES for a pet to develop heat stroke and suffocate in a car. It is best to leave your pet at home on warm days. If you have your dog or cat in the car, make sure to take your pet with you when you leave the car. In hot weather, your pet is happier and more comfortable at home.
- *** **Keep the paws in mind.** The sun can cause surfaces to get extremely hot and burn your pet's paws. Keep your pet off hot cement, asphalt, metal (like truck beds), sand, and any other hot walking surface.
- *** Water and shade. If you and your pet are out in the sun or heat for an extended period of time, make sure there's plenty of water available to avoid dehydration. Also, get your pet into the shade as much as possible.
- *** Keep your windows screened, especially for cats. Cats love windowsills. You may want your house to be ventilated, but you do not want your kitty to fall out of a window.
- *** Keep your pets away from fireworks. Pets are at risk for fatal injuries and painful burns when fireworks are being used. Fireworks also contain chemicals toxic to pets, so make sure your pets do not lick any fireworks residue left on the ground. The loud noises can be frightening to pets causing them to run off and get lost.
- *** Stay safe at BBQs and picnics. BBQs and picnics are a lot of fun, but they can bad for pets. Keep your
